If symptoms persist for more than 2 weeks, ask your doctor for a combination pelvic/rectal exam, CA-125 blood test, and trans-vaginal ultrasound. **A pap test WILL NOT detect ovarian cancer.** PLEASE FORWARD THIS AND KEEP EDUCATING THE WOMEN IN YOUR LIFE!!
