Common Catholic Questions

Are the Pope and the Church really "Infallible"?

The concept of infallibility is one of the most common Catholic questions. It's widely misunderstood. But this topic, properly understood, is an important part of a strong faith in the Risen Lord!

First of all, let's start with the purpose of infallibility: "It is this Magisterium's task to preserve God's people from deviations and defections and to guarantee them the objective possibility of professing the true faith without error.... To fulfill this service, Christ endowed the Church's shepherds with the charism of infallibility in matters of faith and morals."

Infallibility is a gift of Christ and the Holy Spirit that gives us clarity and certainty about the faith itself and morality.

Infallibility just means that certain teachings of the Catholic Church are guaranteed to be without error. That's not to say that they are the full and final word on the topic: later teachings may deepen and further clarify aspects of the original teaching.
