A Note from the Nurse

First, let me express a Great Big THANK YOU for the generous donations to the health office! Secondly, a few reminders:

1. Preschool students require an immunization history and physical (first year only).
2. Kindergarten students require an immunization history, physical, dental exam, and an eye exam by an eye physician.
3. Second grade students require a dental exam.
4. Sixth grade students need an immunization history, physical, and dental exam.
5. Please be sure to fill out the parent portion, sign, and date all the forms.
6. The state required sports physical form (grades 5-8) is different from the school health forms. These are returned to Paul McCue, our Athletic Director.
7. An Allergy Action Plan is required for any student in need of emergency allergy medications, a rescue inhaler, or nebulizer.
