We will begin our baby bottle fundraiser the Friday after Ash Wednesday.

This year again, we will be donating all our collection to Waterleaf. Waterleaf is a life-affirming pregnancy center operated in accord with the teachings of the Catholic Church. They empower women in difficult or untimely pregnancies to embrace the gift of LIFE they have been given, particularly when they have no one else to support them.

This year again, inside each bottle is a prayer from Blessed Fulton Sheen. This Spiritual Adoption of Unborn Human Life Prayer, can be a part of your Lenten journey. Blessed Fulton Sheen encouraged the spiritual adoption of an unborn child. This is done by praying that the one particular, but unknown child's life, be spared abortion and be allowed to continue to live.

As Easy As 1-2-3-4:

1. Pick up a baby bottle after Mass.
2. Take the bottle home and fill it with spare change, cash or a check.
3. Repeat the prayer inside the bottle for your Lenten Journey and continue to complete 9 months.
4. Return bottle to Holy Angels School or Church when filled or after Easter Sunday.

Bottles will be passed out at school to the youngest, for you to take and fill up with your extra change during Lent. You can start returning back to the school or at church when they are filled.
