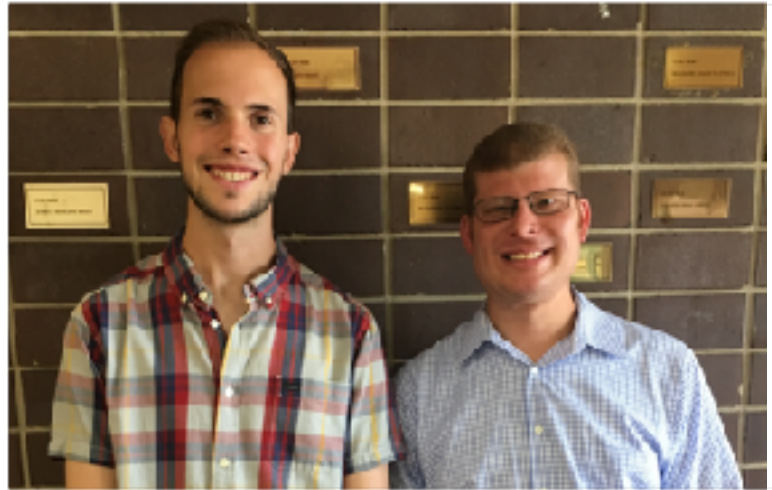
Saving Grace
